The underlying litigation involves the Three Rivers Quarry, one of the largest limestone quarries in the United States. The quarry was held in a trust. The original allegations involved breach of fiduciary duty and an accounting for the royalties from the tonnage produced at the quarry. Appellants also complain of the trial court's denial of their request for a jury trial.
