**ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT CABINET v CONCERNED CITIZENS OF ESTILL
COUNTY, INC.**

Cabinet appeals from order holding that documents were subject to disclosure under Open Records Act. The Cabinet argues that (1) correspondence relating to settlement retains its preliminary status even after the settlement occurs; (2) the correspondence remains subject to the attorney-client and work-product privileges; (3) the circuit court erred by analyzing the disclosure requirement as of the date of settlement, rather than the date of the open records request; (4) there is no statutory requirement that it provide an index of withheld documents; (5) the circuit court relied on erroneous facts; (6) it was entitled to a dismissal based on CCEC's delay in serving the summons. Motions to dismiss appeal as interlocutory passed to the panel.
