Issues include whether the plaintiff, individually, has standing to assert that she is an employee of the cleaning company defendants and entitled to the protections of wage and hour laws when: (1) the plaintiff is the sole member of an LLC that has a franchise agreement with the cleaning-company defendants; (2) the cleaning-company defendants demanded that the plaintiff create the LLC to purchase her franchise; (2) the cleaning-company defendants assisted the plaintiff to form her LLC; and (4) the cleaning-company defendants control the work available to the plaintiff.
