Personal Injury. Limitation of Actions. Revival of Claims. Summary judgment was appropriate on a claim originally filed against a deceased tortfeasor which was amended to substitute the tortfeasor's estate after the limitations period had run. Knowledge of the claim could not be imputed to decedent's estate because the estate did not exist prior to the expiration of the statute of limitations period.

Trial court did not err by failing to remove a juror, grant a mistrial, or grant a motion for a new trial or judgment notwithstanding the verdict, where juror was recognized as an acquaintance by a defense witness late in trial. Further, marking points on a graph based on a cell phone report including latitude and longitude of cell towers does not require expert testimony. Lastly, trial court properly denied the defendant's motion to suppress the victim's identification in a police photo array because police did not present the victim with defendant's photo prior to the array and no state action was involved.

Waiver of an objection to taking testimony of a child victim pursuant to KRS 421.350 may be executed by counsel without personal waiver by defendant and trial court's decision to allow juvenile witnesses to testify in camera was not palpable error.

A layperson insurance adjustor had no duty to advise the opposing party of the death of their insured in order to allow the opposing party to timely file their claim against the insured's estate.
