Trafficking in a Controlled Substance. Fourth Amendment. Search and Seizure. Trial court did not err in denying the defendant's motion to suppress evidence discovered on his person following a search of the vehicle and the defendant-passenger during a routine traffic stop. At issue were a series of questions asked to the driver about his travel plans and a criminal records search. These inquiries were related to the underlying purpose of the traffic stop, and that purpose had not yet concluded. It was also reasonable to detain the defendant-passenger during the search of the vehicle. The items uncovered during the search of the vehicle provided the necessary probable cause to search the defendant-passenger's person.
